Focus - Phonemes q / o / c / k



Phonemes we focused on this week:



Pronunciation phrase- q

Cive me a big smile that shows your teeth; press the middle of your tongue to the top and back of your mouth; push your tongue down and forward to make the g sound g g g

Formation phrase

Round the goat's face and curl under its chin.



Pronunciation phrase- o

Make your mouth into round shape and say o o o

Formation phrase

All around the octopus.



Pronunciation phrase-c

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say c c c

Formation phrase

Curl around the cat.



Pronunciation phrase-k

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say k k k

Formation phrase

Down the kite, up to the top corner and down to the bottom corner.

Pronunciation phrase is used to support saying the phoneme (sound) Formation phrase is used to support writing the grapheme (letter shape)
