Children will learn:

Children will learn to:

HISTORY

Children will learn about:

Similarities and differences between Swavesey now and in the past.

Significant events, people and places in their own locality. Use different sources to find out about life in Swavesey in the past.

PE

Children will learn:

Tennis related skills and basic fundamentals such as travelling with control and throwing and catching with accuracy.

The basics of throwing catching and fielding in Cricket. Athletics skills including running, throwing, jumping in preparation for Sports Day.

SCIENCE

Children will learn to:

Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees

Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Observe changes across the four seasons and observe and describe the weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

ART

Children will learn about:

Drawing, making and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination. They will use a range of materials creatively to design and make works of art.

ENGLISH

Children will:

Children will:

Continue to explore number, calculation, money, fractions, time, shape, statistics, weight, length, position and direction.

MUSIC

Children will learn to:
