Unit of work 'The Ancient Greeks' will include:

**Chronology:** To locate this period in history on a timeline in relation to other time periods we have learnt about.

**Historical Knowledge:** To find out what life was like in Ancient Greece; identifying the key features of that society and how it compares to our lives today.

**Evidence:** To use a range of evidence to build up our understanding of life in Ancient Greek times. To distinguish between different sources and their usefulness in finding out about the past. To look at different representations of the same event. To ask questions.

**Organisation and Communication:** Recall, select and organise historical information.

**Impact:** Learn about the legacy of Greek culture including art, architecture and literature.

## **ENGLISH:**

We will explore a variety of different fiction and non-fiction text types this term that will include:

- Myths and Legends
- Narratives story writing
- Non-Chronological Reports
- Poetry
- News Reports

Our Reading Spine Books will be The Boy at the Back of the Class by Onjali Rauf and The Battle of Bubble and Squeak by Philippa Pearce.

DT: (2nd half term) Healthy and varied diet:

We will explore healthy and varied diets, taste Greek food and discuss our likes and dislikes, create a healthy menu for a Greek restaurant, prepare and cook Greek food for a banquet, taste food that we have cooked and evaluate our dishes.

# **MATHS**

Number work will involve the four operations with a special focus on problem solving activities and reasoning.

Shape, money, data handling, time and capacity will also be covered.

## ICT:

**Research**: Use of Ipads and Internet for research work will enrich our understanding of our unit.

Units of work will include: Online Safety, Branching Diagrams and Spreadsheets.
