Science Light: Shadow Puppets

You will need:

- Paper/Card to cut out and make into a puppet shape
- Stick (such as a lollypop stick/straw/twig)
- · Sticky tape
- Scissors
- · A torch and a piece of white paper for a screen.



<u>Activity 1</u> Make a shadow puppet by drawing and cutting out a character of your choice. This could be an animal or a super hero - the choice is yours. Attach your puppet character to a stick.

Hold the torch directly above the piece of paper. Put the puppet in front of the torch. An alternative to this is to use a wall in a darkened room as a screen and then shining the torch towards the wall. Explore by moving the puppet closer to the torch and then further away.
